



Patrick D'Arcy

Patrick D'Arcy became a Governor at St Augustine's Priory in September 2015 (having previously served as a co-opted member of the Finance Committee for 18 months). He became Chair of Governors in January 2020.

Born in Ireland, Patrick graduated with a BSc in Construction Economics at what is now the TU in Dublin before moving to Scotland where he lived in Glasgow and Edinburgh for 18 months working for a multinational engineering firm.
