Breakfast and After School Club

We provide Breakfast Club and After School Club services on site, daily throughout the school term.

Early Morning Care Provision

A supervised Breakfast Club is provided Monday to Friday from 8am – 8.30am in the Pupils' Refectory for pupils from Nursery – Year 6.

Parents' drop children to Breakfast Club in the Pupils' Refectory via the Prep Playground.

The cost of the early morning care provision without breakfast is £2.65 and with breakfast included is £5.20* per day (ad hoc admission) which will be charged to your school account.

*your child must arrive by 8.15am to enjoy the breakfast

We provide a variety of breakfast cereals, toast, eggs, croissants, fresh fruit, juice and hot chocolate.

After School Club

A supervised After School Club is provided Monday to Friday from 3.30pm – 6pm in the Refectories for pupils from Nursery to Year 6.

After School Club Staff collect Nursery – Year 2 from their classrooms at the end of the school day and Year 3 – Year 6 pupils make their own way to the Refectories. Parents' collect pupils from the Refectories via the Prep Playground. We provide a homework area as well as educational activities, puzzles, games, arts & crafts, a book corner, role play, Spanish conversation and outdoor play. Snacks such as fruit, pitta or brown bread sandwiches, pasta salads and the occasional treat are provided.

Please note that pre-booking or same day booking is required.

LAMDA examinations improve communication skills, increase confidence & develop strong social skills

Introduction

30 sessions are offered per academic year. Adjustments are made for lessons missed owing to teacher absence. Refunds are not made for student absence for any reason, including sickness, exams, trips etc.

2024/25

- Group lessons £132 + VAT per student per term
- Individual lessons £300 + VAT per student per term
- Pair £150 + VAT per student per term
- One-off individual £30 + VAT lessons

Please note that a half term's notice is required of termination of LAMDA lessons or a half term's fees in lieu of notice will be charged. For Musical Theatre lessons this is one full term due to the group nature of the exam content. Therefore, notice must be given before half term to finish LAMDA lessons at the end of a term or before the start of term for Musical Theatre. Unless notice is received your daughter will be enrolled automatically for lessons the next term. All fees will be charged to your school account at the end of the term when the lessons take place.

LAMDA examinations for each grade take place once per academic year. LAMDA entrance fees are charged separately and cost different amounts depending on the subject and grade. Notification will be sent of upcoming examinations and, should you wish to enter your daughter, the examination entrance fee would be added to your school account.

Subjects at St Augustine's Priory

Group and individual lessons are offered in...



Introducing learners to basic communication skills. Learners will speak one poem from memory, audibly and clearly with some appreciation of Introductory meaning and maintain a short conversation with the examiner about a favourite toy or object, picture and book.



Developing a strong speaking voice and good memory skills by learning and performing monologues and duologues. Designed for solo or duologue performances.



Speaking Developing the skills necessary for effective oral communication and public presentation. These lessons will benefit native English speakers as well as those for whom English is a second language.



Learners interpret a rich variety of poems and novels, developing a strong speaking voice and memory skills. Designed for individual candidates.



LAMDA examinations in Musical Theatre help students to develop their Musical acting and singing skills. Like our Acting exams, they encourage empathy and self awareness, as learners are required to present believable characters through both acting and song.

Individual lessons are also offered in...


Devising Developing creativity by exploring ideas and themes and realising them through devised dramatic performances. Designed for solo or duologue performances.



Gaining an understanding of non-verbal communication by exploring body language and facial expression, and putting them into a dramatic performance. Designed for solo or performances.



Learners construct and present a recital based on a theme of their choice, using an introduction, verse readings, prose readings, dramatic readings, reflective linking statements and a conclusion. Texts are not memorised



Taskmaster Club is an exciting weekly club where Alex Horne, creator of Taskmaster, works with the Club Taskmaster (Mrs Cattigan) to set tasks for children that will test their powers of ingenuity, creativity and teamwork.
